Curriculum outline

Reading: We will be focussing on developing our reading skills using the text "Stig of the dump"

Writing: We will be looking at a non-fiction holiday brochure - Skara Brae and the narrative 'The Iron Man'.

Maths: We will be continuing to look at fractions. We will then look at mass & capacity and money.

Science: We will be studying - animals including humans. We will be able to identify that animals, including humans, need the right types and amount of nutrition. We will identify that humans and some other animals have skeletons and muscles for support, protection and movement.

History: We will be studying the Iron Age.
