Our current learning journey is: Rome

Curriculum outline

Reading: We will be studying the book 'Thieves of Ostia' by Caroline Lawrence. We are also studying and analysing extracts from other texts. **Writing:** We will be writing a persuasive piece of text to persuade people to visit Ostia. We will also be completing our own narratives based on the book 'The Firework Makers Daughter'.

Maths: We will be continuing our learning on decimals. We will then move on to our learning about money and time.

Physical Development: The focus this half term will be tennis and cricket. Half of these lessons will be delivered by the Maltby Academy PE specialist. **Science:** We will be focusing on the topic 'animals and living things' in biology. This includes learning about our teeth and the digestive system. **Geography:** The focus this half term will be about Rome. We will compare Rome to where we live.

DT: In DT, we will be creating our own Italian biscotti. We will be researching the ingredients and method used to create these and then evaluating our own creations.

Computing: We will be using the program 'Crumble' to create our own robot orchestra.

MFL: Our next MFL topic is 'Mi Familia' – my family.
