Our current learning journey is: **Romans**

Curriculum outline

Reading: We will be studying the book 'Into the volcano' by Jess Butterworth. We are also studying and analysing extracts from other texts.

Writing: We will be exploring different types of writing by creating our own diary entries and creating a biography about the Romans.

Maths: We will be starting a new topic about shapes, then moving onto statistics and finally looking at position and direction.

Physical Development: The focuses this half term will be a continuation of with tennis and cricket and then moving onto athletics. Half of these lessons will be delivered by the Maltby Academy PE specialist.

Science: We will be continuing to focus on the topic 'animals and living things' in biology. This includes learning about our teeth and the digestive system.

History: The focus this half term will be about the Romans. We will evaluate how the Roman Empire effected Britain.

Art: In art, we will be creating a sculpture based on Monomi Ohno about the Romans.

Computing: We will be understanding the internet.

MFL: Our next MFL topic is '¿Tienes una mascota?' – Do you have a pet?

PSHE: We will continue to discuss the topic of 'Keeping myself safe'.
