Welcome to the Summer 1 edition of the Year 3 newsletter. You will find lots of information about the curriculum, how to help your child at home and any other notes. If you have any questions, please ask the class teacher.

Our current learning journey is: **Who was Tutankhamun and how did he live and die?**

Curriculum outline

Reading: We will be reading 'An Egyptian Adventure' by Frances Durkin alongside a range of unseen extracts to develop our retrieval, inference and vocabulary skills.

Writing: We will be writing a character description to entertain our audience based on characters from 'Inside the Pyramid'. We will also write a narrative to entertain based on 'The Egyptian Cinderella'.

Maths: We will build on our knowledge of fractions and start to add and subtract them. We will also explore money and time.

Science: We will be learning all about plants. We will learn what plants need and the functions the different parts have. We will also look at how plants reproduce and seed dispersal.

History: We will be exploring who the Ancient Egyptians were focusing on who was Tutankhamun and his life and death.

Art: We will be using clay to make our own Egyptian Canopic Jars based on Gustav Klint.

MFL: Our MFL unit is 'Se' - 'I know how'.

PSHE: We will be doing a unit of work about economic wellbeing, learning about different payment methods and when to use them, understand the benefits of budgeting, explore feelings and impacts around money choices, and recognise how skills and interests can lead to a wide range of jobs.

Computing: We will be creating Story Graphs.

Physical Development: The focus this half term will be Athletics and OAA.
