## Curriculum Outline

### Communication and Language Development

We will be using a wider range of vocabulary through reading, sharing and remembering longer stories. We will also be starting conversations with an adult or a friend about holidays we have been on.

### Physical Development

We are going to be developing our fine motor skills using one handed tools and equipment. We will also be developing our gross motor skills as we practise different physical skills in preparation for sports day.

### Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will be meeting our new class teacher and friends and enjoy exploring our new classroom ready to move into Reception. Our younger children in Nursery will be meeting their new friends that will be joining us in September.

### Literacy (Reading and Writing)

We will share and enjoy new and familiar stories and Nursery rhymes together such as '1,2,3,4,5 once I caught a fish alive, Go Go Pirate Boat and Peppa goes on Holiday'. We will continue to learn our new sounds in RWI and begin to form these letters.

### Maths

We will be learning about the composition of different numbers to 5 and matching quantities of objects to the correct numeral. We will also be making AB repeating patterns and sorting and comparing objects.

### Understanding the world

We will be learning about floating and sinking, linking to how boats float on the sea. We will also be looking at other countries across the world and compare these to where we live.

### Expressive Arts and Design

We will be developing our DT skills by making a boat that can float. We will need to use a range of tools and think carefully about how to join two materials together.

## Helping your child at home

•Read with your child at least 3 times a week. This may be a book from home or the 'must read' text in your child's book bag. **Books are changed on a Friday.**

•Encourage your child's independence by helping them to get dressed, put their coats on, put their shoes on and use the toilet **by themselves.**

•Help to increase your child's vocabulary and experiences by sharing different stories and talking about what is happening around them.

•Share the different Nursery Rhymes that we have been learning at school and talk about what is happening in them.

•Have conversations with your child at any available opportunity to develop their communication and language skills.

•Use the resources provided in your child's book bag such as their name card to practise writing their name.
