Our current learning journey is: **Which Capital City in the UK would you most like to visit?**

Curriculum outline

Reading: This half term, we are continuing to use Read, Write Inc to learn sounds and blend them together to read decodable words. The focus for this half term is Set 3 sounds. We will also be sharing a selection of stories and giving our opinions on them.

Writing: This half term, we are going to be learning about and writing poems at the beginning and towards the end we will be reading the book 'How to Grow a Unicorn' by Rachel Morrisroe.

Maths: This half term's maths focus place value to 100. Children will use equipment and pictorial representations to identify tens and ones and partition numbers. Once this is secure, children will be looking at position and direction and money.

Science: The children will be learning about seasons. The children will be looking at the differences between the four seasons and discussing Summer.

DT: This half term we are going to be focusing on textiles in DT and learning how to sew.

History: We will be learning about our locality and discussing and changes that have happened and how we can relate these to wider UK changes.

Helping your child at home

To support your child at home, you could:

- Listen to them read each night and record this in their planner
- Support and encourage them to complete the set maths activity.
- Watch the phonic videos sent home for your child's colour group.
- Practise reading the real and nonsense words sent home.
