Our current learning journey is: **Field Work: Land Use**

Curriculum outline

Reading: We will be reading 'Accidental Prime Minister' by Tom McLaughlin alongside a range of unseen extracts to develop our retrieval, inference and vocabulary skills. We will start to engage in more complex questioning.

Writing: We will be writing a poem called 'Summer is Here'. We will be consolidating our knowledge of subordinating and coordinating conjunctions, as well as our knowledge of dialogue. We will continue to use paragraphs.

Maths: We will build on our knowledge about shape, statistics, length and perimeter.

Science: We will complete our learning on plants. We will then be taking part in some scientific knowledge projects linked to different science topics we have done throughout the year.

Geography: We will be carrying out fieldwork and using map skills. We will look at the types of land within Yorkshire and the Humber region. We will look at recording data linked to our local area as well as conducting surveys.

DT: We will be focusing on a textile's unit. We will be practicing our sewing skills to create a desired final product.

MFL: Our Spanish unit is 'Las Estaciones' The Seasons.

PSHE: We will be doing a unit of work about transition and our emotions during times of transition.

Computing: We will be using adobe spark to explain networks.

Physical Development: The focus this half term will be rounders and athletics.
