Our current learning journey is: How do I get to ...? (an independent fieldwork enquiry)

Curriculum outline

Reading: We are studying the Nonsense poem of 'The Walrus and Carpenter' by Lewis Carroll as well as the narrative 'The Wolves of Willoughby Hall'.

Writing: Linking our writing to our topic, we will be writing a 'nonsense' narrative poem based on The 'Hope-o-potamus' and we will be writing a romantic narrative based on 'The Paperman' short animated film.

Maths: We will be learning place value, addition, subtraction, multiplication and division including formal methods of long multiplication and division.

Science: We will be investigating light and shadow including experiments involving torches, mirrors and water to show reflection and refraction.

Physical Development: Football and netball will be delivered by Mrs White.

Geography: We will be learning about fieldwork in the local environment, collecting data and mapping routes.

Art: We will be looking at powerful imagery and street art; using the chiaroscuro method of shading lettering and images.

Computing: We will be creating our own video games with lead characters, scoring systems and a 'baddie'.

MEL: Spanish specialist teacher from MA will deliver Spanish this half-term.
